




DATA ANALYSIS

The data included in this report is charted and graphed to illustrate and compare changes over a specific time period. These charts and graphs are utilized to assist in determining crime trends and to measure enforcement efforts. This data is utilized in conjunction with other analysis to develop directed patrol and various enforcement activities. The analysis included on these pages is presented as a brief highlight to explain the salient points of this report.





MONTHLY CASE HIGHLIGHTS

Robbery

- Robbery to a person involving a lotto scam, victim gave \$1,450 to suspects in return for cashing in a lottery ticket. Possible relation to incidents in other Districts. TOT to Robbery Division.
- Two instances reported of (2) male subjects brandishing a firearm and robbing victims of belongings while walking. TOT to Robbery Division.
- One robbery occurred at Marathon gas station; suspect pointed a gun at two clerks and took cash from the register. TOT to Robbery Division.

Sexual Assault

- Case turned over to Special Investigations due to occurring in 2003/2004.

Burglary

- One juvenile subject was *arrested* for committing (2) residential burglaries, transported to Juvenile Assessment Center. (1) Juvenile was *arrested* for a residential burglary and transported to Juvenile Assessment Center. (1) Juvenile was detained for a residential burglary; however, victim signed a *refusal to prosecute notice*.
- Majority of vehicle burglaries were unlocked. Two construction burglaries of AC equipment involved a U-Haul truck.

Vandalism

- Majority of incidents involved damage to vehicles. One warrant will be filed with the State's Attorney's Office.

Stolen Vehicle

- Majority of vehicles stolen were motorcycles and trailers. One of the trailers stolen involved a U-Haul truck, possibly related to construction burglaries involving AC equipment.

Stolen Vehicle Recoveries

- *(2) Arrests* made on a vehicle stolen out of Boynton Beach. Majority of vehicles recovered were stolen out of another city

Shooting

- Two subjects standing outside when an unknown vehicle approached and shot one subject. Case turned over to Violent Crimes.

Field Interview Reports: 115 conducted.

Enforcement/Action Plans:

The recently created District 16 Street Crimes Unit conducted a 7 Day "Gang Enforcement" Initiative in the City of Greenacres. The D16 Street Team, along with assistance from the District 1 Street Team, District 3 CP Surveillance Team, and the Gang Unit participated in identifying various gang members and related criminal activity within the city.

The operation was a success in enhancing the PBSO gang data base. The high profile operation also sent a message to gang members and associates in the city, that PBSO is taking a zero tolerance stance toward their criminal behavior.
