SUBJECT: 2016 MUNICIPAL ELECTION RESULTS
DATE: March 16, 2016

Pursuant to the City Charter, general elections for the purpose of electing officers of the City are held on the second Tuesday in March. At the request of the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, the Municipal Election was held on March 15, 2016 to coincide with the Presidential Preference Primary as authorized by Governor Rick Scott on March 19, 2015. The offices up for election included the Offices of City Council Districts II, III and IV.

As required by Florida Statutes, public notices were published in the Greenacres Observer and el Latino Semanal informing the public of the qualifying and filing period for the 2016 Municipal Election. Upon the close of the qualifying and filing period on November 17, 2015, the following candidates filed for office:

The City of Greenacres (pop. 38,943) is comprised of sixteen (16) precincts with eight (8) polling locations for the 19,172 registered voters. Upon the closing of the polls on March 15, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. and having counted the 5,139 ballots for the City of Greenacres, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections provided the following results:


