

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-14

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENACRES, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A LOWE'S COMMUNITY PARTNERS GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE LEISURE SERVICES DEPARTMENT, YOUTH PROGRAMS DIVISION FOR ADDITIONAL PROGRAM FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 TO BE USED FOR EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City's Youth Programs Division has been established since 1995 to provide students Kindergarten through high school with a safe, structured, and beneficial environment during out-of-school time representing over 18 different schools in the Greenacres' area and surrounding community; and

WHEREAS, the City's Youth Programs Division desires to submit a contribution request to Lowe's Community Partners Grant for \$7,246 for additional program supply funding to be used for new computers in FY2016 for educational enrichment and homework assistance; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees it is in the best interest of the program participants to secure additional sources of funding to supplement the budget, offset expenses and provide advancements in computer technology for program participants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENACRES, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council grants authorization for the submittal of the application of the Lowe's Community Partners Grant for use in FY2016.

Section 2. The City authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute and submit the grant application for the Lowe's Community Partners Grant.
