COUNCIL POLICY NO. 12

APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY MAYOR

CROSS REFERENCES: Article II, Section 2, City Charter
Article III, Section 2, City Charter

POLICY PURPOSE:

It is the purpose of this policy to establish procedures for the appointment of a Deputy Mayor by the City Council as required by the City Charter.

POLICY:

At the first regularly scheduled City Council meeting in April of each year, the Mayor shall nominate one (1) of the members of the City Council to serve as Deputy Mayor for the coming year. The City Council shall then appoint by majority vote, either the Mayor's nominee or any other member of the Council that it may choose. Any nominee for Deputy Mayor must have served one (1) full term as a Council member prior to being eligible for nomination. In addition, no Council member may serve as Deputy Mayor in excess of two (2) successive years.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This policy shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.






