




DATA ANALYSIS

The data included in this report is charted and graphed to illustrate and compare changes over a specific time period. These charts and graphs are utilized to assist in determining crime trends and to measure enforcement efforts. The analysis included on these pages is presented as a brief highlight to explain the salient points of this report.





MONTHLY CASE HIGHLIGHTS

Burglary

- Majority of vehicle burglaries (15) occurred within the Pine Ridge Communities.
- Crime Spree of vehicle burglaries (8) occurred between 4/29/16 – 4/30/16 within Pine Ridge North I. All vehicle windows were smashed to gain entry.

Robbery

- Home invasion robbery in Pickwick Park East involving a male & female subject. Case is currently being investigated.
- Person robbery involving victim meeting (met on Facebook) a subject in Pines Plaza to sell shoes. (2) Subjects showed up demanding items, one of them having a gun. Case is currently being investigated.

Sexual Assault

- Incident where victim met subject at his residence. She rushed out of house and was involved in a crash within District 1 and arrested for DUI. Claimed to possibly be drugged due to not recalling driving. Case TOT VCD.

Shooting

- Shooting occurred at Walmart. Victim was shot in the chest while selling drugs and transported to Delray Medical Center. Currently being investigated.

Stolen Vehicle

- (4) Total vehicles stolen - (2) were stolen out of Pickwick MHP East, both recovered.

Stolen Vehicle Recoveries

- (1) Recovered, suspect believed to be ex-boyfriend. Pending contact with suspect.

Vandalism

- Juveniles have been damaging the stockade fence in Gladiator Park.
- Rear window of victim's vehicle shattered by a BB or pellet. Unknown subjects have been shooting out street lights in the area.


Theft
