




DATA ANALYSIS

The data included in this report is charted and graphed to illustrate and compare changes over a specific time period. These charts and graphs are utilized to assist in determining crime trends and to measure enforcement efforts. This data is utilized in conjunction with other analysis to develop directed patrol and various enforcement activities. The analysis included on these pages is presented as a brief highlight to explain the salient points of this report.





MONTHLY CASE HIGHLIGHTS

Burglary

- Business burglary involving the theft of \$14,500 worth of pipes at “All About Smoke”.
- (2) **Handguns** were stolen from residential burglaries.
- Majority of vehicle burglaries were entered through an unlocked door.
- Vehicle sprees occurred at Fairways Isle at Olive Tree on 5/08/16 (3 vehicles) & Parkside Green on 5/06/16 (4 vehicles)
- Three vehicle burglaries were reported in the Parkside Green development. Detectives developed probable cause on three suspects. **Arrests pending.**

Robbery

- Suspect attempted to steal a purse from victim in parking lot of Target. He was later identified and questioned. **Cleared by arrest.**
- Victim was approached by multiple suspects; one with a gun demanded him to get out of vehicle. Victim was able to flee scene. One suspect was identified. **Arrest warrant has been filed.**

Sexual Assault

- None reported

Shooting

- None reported

Stolen Vehicle

- (5) Total vehicles stolen.
- Witnesses observed one of the stolen vehicles involved in a crash. Multiple subjects exited the vehicle, one of them shooting a gun into the air. They fled the scene on foot.

Stolen Vehicle Recoveries

- Stolen vehicle out of District 3 was identified by a Lojack hit. Multiple suspects detained. **Cleared by arrest.**

Vandalism

- Witness observed a female subject slashing complainant’s tires. **Probably Cause exists to file charges.**

Theft

- Complainant reported **gun** missing from his mattress. Wife believes he might have thrown it out with other belongings.

District Initiatives:

- District 16 Street Crimes unit in conjunctions with the Florida Division of Alcohol Beverages and Tobacco (ABT) as well as the City of Greenacres Code Enforcement conducted 'Operation Cold One' to combat the sale of alcohol and tobacco to minors within the City of Greenacres. Three underage ABT Investigative Aides (IA) were used in an attempt to purchase both alcohol and tobacco. A total of 17 establishments were checked; in which (4) clerks sold to the IAs. The owner of one establishment was arrested for Sale of Alcohol not Permitted by License (On-premise consumption).
- The Motor Unit conducted two Wolfpack Operations in District 16 during the month of May. The first Wolfpack Operation was held on May 9-10, 2016 and second was held on May 24-25, 2016.
- On May 27, 2016 the District 16 Street Crimes Unit with the assistance of the District 16 Detective Bureau, Districts 1 and 13 Street Crimes Units conducted an Undercover Prostitution Operation in the City of Greenacres. During the operation, Deputies (Decoys) posed as street level prostitutes at various predetermined locations within the city limits.
- District 16 conducted a Traffic Initiative on May 20, 2016.
