



DATA ANALYSIS

The data included in this report is charted and graphed to illustrate and compare changes over a specific time period. These charts and graphs are utilized to assist in determining crime trends and to measure enforcement efforts. This data is utilized in conjunction with other analysis to develop directed patrol and various enforcement activities. The analysis included on these pages is presented as a brief highlight to explain the salient points of this report.







MONTHLY CASE HIGHLIGHTS

Burglary

- Business burglary at EDS Food Store where suspect gained access via the roof. Suspect has been identified and pending further investigation.
- Two incidents of AC equipment theft at construction locations. **Cleared by (2) arrests.**
- Multiple vehicle burglaries to marked PBSO units where windows were smashed.
- Vehicle spree occurred at Oak Terrace between 6/15/16 – 6/16/16 involving (9) vehicles. Windows were shattered. Majority of vehicles had nothing taken.

Robbery

- Suspect punched victim and took \$60. Suspect was identified. **Cleared by arrest.**

Sexual Assault

- Suspect sexually battered victim at the rear of plaza near the movie theater. Suspect was identified. **Cleared by arrest.**
- Victim reported that (2) known suspects forced their way into residence and forced victim to perform unwilling sexual acts. Pending interview w/victim.

Stolen Vehicle

- (7) Vehicles stolen, (3) of them recovered outside D16's territory.

Stolen Vehicle Recoveries

- (1) Vehicle recovered that was reported stolen out of Lantana PD.

Vandalism

- Spree of damaged cars in Wood Lakes between 6/18/16 – 6/19/16 where vehicle windows were smashed by rocks. Similar incidents in other communities.

Theft

- Theft of a cell-phone from the break room at Goodwill. An employee admitted to the theft. Victim decided not to press charges. Employee was going to be terminated.
- Witness (tenant) observed suspect taking items out of residence and pawning them.
Charges to be filed with State's Attorney's Office.
